

Instructions for Holders of Tourist Visa/ Special Tourist Visa And nationals who are entitled for Visa Exemption

STEP 1:

A) In case you need a visa, apply for a Tourist Visa or Special Tourist Visa (STV). Please find list of required document at <https://www.thaiembassy.ch/Content/Embassy/57.html>

B) Entering Thailand under Tourist Visa Exemption

Foreigners entering Thailand under the Tourist Visa Exemption category must provide proof of adequate funding for the duration of stay in Thailand at the port of entry (i.e., traveler's cheque or cash equivalent to 20,000 Baht per person and 40,000 Baht per family), proof of onward travel (confirmed air, train, bus or boat tickets) to leave Thailand within 30 days of the arrival date, otherwise a tourist visa must be obtained.

STEP 2: Apply for a Certificate of Entry (CoE) at online central registration system <http://coethailand.mfa.go.th/>

Once all required document is completely uploaded, the CoE will be issued is within 3 working days.

The applicant needs to submit the following documents online to complete the application:

- (1) A copy of applicant's passport

(2) A copy of **valid visa** (in case you have a visa)

(3) The airlines ticket confirmation ([Click here for list of semi-commercial flights.](#))

The semi-commercial flights transport entitled passengers to Bangkok regularly. Please contact the airlines ticket office directly for buying the tickets.

(4) A copy of **valid Health Insurance certificate**, indicating that the insurance covers all medical expenditures including COVID-19, and worth more than or at least USD 100,000.- (Certified insurance packages are available at <http://covid19.tgia.org/>)

(5) A **booking confirmation from ASQ/ ALQ/ AHQ facilities:**

- **Arriving in Bangkok:** Please book a quarantine hotel in Bangkok, Chonburi, Smutprakarn and Prachinburi only.

- **Arriving in Phuket:** Please book a quarantine hotel in Phuket and Phang-Nga only.

STEP 3: Obtaining Certificate of Entry (CoE)

The status and the result of the CoE application can be checked on the [online central registration system](#) with your log-in account. The applicant is requested to print out the CoE to present to airlines staff on your departure date.

STEP 4: Presenting documents for boarding flight(s) to Bangkok

Non-Thai national passengers will be asked by the check-in staff to present the following documents for issuing boarding pass:

(1) The Certificate of Entry (CoE)

(2) A copy of **Covid-19 free Health Certificate by RT-PCR test, within 72 hours before departure.** (It should be in English with date and time of the examination.)

(3) A copy of **Fit to Fly/Fit to Travel certificate, within 72 hours before departure.** ([click to download](#))

* From 1st of April 2021, Fit to Fly certificate will **NOT** be required.

(4) A copy of **valid Health Insurance certificate** indicating that the insurance covers all medical expenditures in Thailand including COVID-19, inpatient, outpatient, and worth more than or at least USD 100,000.- (Certified insurance packages are available at <http://covid19.tgia.org/>)

(5) Tor 8 Form ([click to download](#))

**Remarks: Passengers who fail to present the abovementioned documents to the airlines staff, will be strictly denied boarding the plane.*
